## 1 Overview

Query parameters allow you to pass configuration options in the URL to the Web Meeting platform.

The query parameters need to be URL encoded:

`https://<your link>/path/?participantName=Test%20User&meetingPassword=1234`

## 2 Available starting from Version 6.5

Parameter name	Possible Values	Default	Description
participantName	Any string	empty	The name of the participant. Will pre-fill the form on the "Join Meeting" screen. Required if "skipJoinMeetingScreen» is true
participantEmail	Any email address	empty	The email address of the participant. Will pre-fill the form on the "Join Meeting" screen
registerEmail	Any email address	empty	Only relevant if "Free Trial Registration" is enabled. Will pre-fill the email address field of the "Register Trial Account" registration form.
registerFrom	Any string	empty	Only relevant if "Free Trial Registration" is enabled. Will add an additional "from" field to the email notification to the system admin. Useful to track the source.
meetingPassword	Any string	empty	The meeting password. Will pre-fill the form on the "Join Meeting" screen.

meetingRoomLayout	standard, video-only, collaboration-only	standard	Defines if both video and collaboration tools should be shown on the screen. Useful for classroom setups with multiple displays. One display could only show the collaboration tools whereas another display only shows the video streams. By default, both video and the collaboration tools are shown
mediaDirection	standard, receiveonly, sendonly	standard	Defines in which direction media should flow in a meeting. By default, media is both sent and received. Useful in conjunction with the "meetingRoomLayout" option. The display that only shows the collaboration tool might not want to receive incoming audio.
joinType	audio-only, audio-video, video-only, no-media	audio-video	Pre-selects the "joinType" on the "Join Meeting" screen. Useful in conjunction with "skipJoinMeetingScreen"
moderatorToken	Valid moderator token	empty	The moderator token that gives a participant moderator rights in a meeting
autoJoin	DEPRECATED		Please use "joinType" in conjunction with "skipJoinMeetingScreen" instead
leaveUrl	Any URL	empty	Overwrites the default URL behind the "Leave Meeting" button.
jwtToken	Any JWT token	empty	The authentication token of a user. Useful if authentication happens in a third-party tool

skipJoinMeetingScreen	true, false	false	<p>Skips the "Join Meeting" screen. Important: The "participantName" field MUST be set. If the meeting is password protected, then the "meetingPassword" field also MUST be set.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: This feature may not work as expected in webinars. Modern browsers don't allow playing videos without prior user interactions with the website. Webinar participants joining with "skipJoinMeetingScreen" might not see the presenters' video. We therefore recommend to NOT use this parameter.</p>
meetingAccessToken	true, false	false	<p>The access token for a specific meeting. Required if a external meeting authorization service is configured.</p>
hideConsentSection	true, false	false	<p>Hide the consent checkbox on the "Join Meeting" screen.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: You are required to ask for the users consent somewhere else if you enable this feature.</p>
hideLegalAndComplianceSection	true, false	false	<p>Hide the legal and compliance section on the "Join Meeting" screen, i.e. the Imprint and Privacy Policy links, if configured.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: You are required to ask for the users consent somewhere else if you enable this feature.</p>

hideJoinModeSection	true, false	false	Hide the "Join Mode" section on the "Join Meeting" screen. If "joinType" is not available, the system automatically chooses "audio-video" by default.
disableEmailInput	true, false	false	Disables the participant name input field on the "Join Meeting" screen. Requires the "participantName" to be passed in the query parameter.
disableNameInput	true, false	false	Disables the participant email input field on the "Join Meeting" screen.
disablePasswordInput	true, false	false	Disables the meeting password input field on the "Join Meeting" screen.
enableFollowMe	true, false	false	Enables the "Follow Me" feature. Will only work if the participant is the organizer or a moderator of the meeting.
testWithoutRenderingMedia	true, false	false	For testing purposes only: don't render audio and video, only send and receive the streams
